MATHS:

Fractions
Recognise and show, using diagrams, families of common equivalent fractions.
Count up and down in hundredths; recognise that hundredths arise when dividing an object by one hundred and dividing tenths by ten.
Solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities, including non-unit fractions where the answer is a whole number.
Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.
Time
Convert between different units of measure, e.g. hour to minute.
Read, write & convert time between analogue and digital 12 and 24 hour clocks.
Solve problems involving converting from hours to minutes; minutes to seconds; years to months; weeks to days.
